

Ángel Ramírez

Check on the mural on the side of the Cary & Main Building! Completed in October of 2023 by Cuban artist Ángel Ramírez, in collaboration with artists Hanoi Pérez and Yuniell Pérez. Of this collaboration, Ángel Ramírez describes the intention of the mural as "Capturing the

colors of the seasons, daily chores, the joy of children, and the kindness of passerby."

Ángel Ramírez's art is recognizable by its clear and precise iconoclastic sagacity. Using recycled objects, text and images, many taken from medieval times, he builds a language that reveals daily life in Cuba today. *Photo credit: Caledonian Record*

Star Theater Building 1 Eastern Avenue Larry Golden


Location 9
